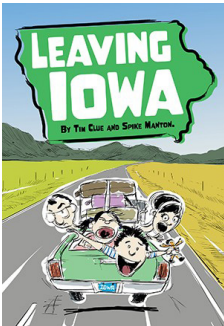

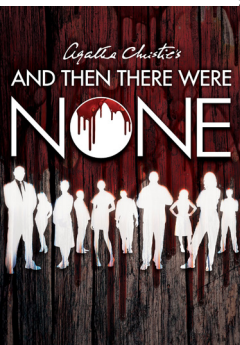
Leaving Iowa March 14 - 23, 2025
